- The text is in Time New Roman, 12 pt.
- Start the first paragraph with indentation.
- Keywords: Maximum 4 words (Time New Roman 12 pt)

Section 2 Content

- Use Time New Roman 12 pt throughout the text.
- Level 1 title (e.g., Introduction, Literature Review, and Methodology) is flushed left, boldface, in title case heading.
- Start every paragraph with indentation (1 tab).
- Level 2 title (i.e., 1.1, 2.1) is flushed left, in boldface, title case heading.
- Level 3 title (i.e., 1.1.1, 2.1.1) is flushed left, in boldface *italic*, title case heading.
- For both tables and figures:
 - o The table or figure number is written in boldface, Time New Roman, 12 pt.
 - o Titles of the table/figure should be in italicized title case below the table/figure number, with a blank line between the number and the title.
 - o Use Time New Roman 10 in the tables and, if possible, in the graphs or charts.
 - o Leave 1 line between the tables/figures and the text.
 - o Number all tables with Arabic numerals sequentially.

Section 3 About the Author(s)

- The level 1 title is flushed left, boldface, in title case heading.
- Start every paragraph with indentation.
- This section should not exceed 150 words.

Section 4 References

- The level 1 title is centered, boldface, in title case heading.
- Follow the APA Style (6th edition).

Section 5 Appendices (Optional)
